

## Sample codicil form

If you already have a Will, sometimes the easiest way to leave a legacy to St Michael's Fellowship is by writing a codicil, which is a short legal document that alters your Will to reflect your new wishes. You can make any number of codicils to amend an existing Will.

We strongly recommend you seek advice from a solicitor to finalise the codicil and ensure it is legally correct and works in the way you want it to. In some circumstances it may be better to create a new Will – your solicitor can advise you. We cannot give you legal advice.

This is a suggested sample codicil for adding a gift to St Michael's Fellowship in your Will. After taking legal advice, you can fill in this form **in the presence of two witnesses** (who must be adults and unrelated) to include a gift to St Michael's Fellowship. Make sure you keep the codicil with your Will so your executors can find it.
